Sports Funding Action Plan
2018-2019

Set out below is a proposed action plan for the 2018-2019 allocation of monies for Bramcote C of E Primary School.

In addition to monies spent in our action plan, we employ a sports coach to teach the children participation and sports skills for one day per week, whilst running an after-school club one night a week. We have also invested in the Broxtowe Active Schools Sports Scheme. This gives access to an extended calendar of inter and intra-school events, community sport links, networking and development opportunities within the family of schools. The cost of this will be £1900 from September 2018 to July 2020.

In July 2018, we were awarded the Silver School Games Mark. We have used the development points from this to formulate the Action Plan below.
