

Remote learning Protocol Bramcote C of E Primary School



In the event of a child/children being unable to attend school due to Covid-19, the following procedures will be followed:

Single child staying at home awaiting test result for themselves or a family member:

- Parents continue to support the child through normal homework activities e.g. Spelling practise, mental maths practise, topic tasks, reading, My Maths activities etc.

Child or family member with positive test result resulting in self-isolation (well enough to work)

- Parent to contact school to advise of absence.
- Office manager will inform relevant class teacher of expected period of absence.
- Class teacher will communicate with the family via class dojo to sign-post school planning information.
- Class teacher to send information via Class email of key objectives being delivered in maths and English for the expected period of absence.
- Class teacher to provide links to relevant websites for lessons and follow-up worksheets
- Class teacher will be available between 3.30pm-4.30pm weekdays for support via Class Dojo or phone call.

Child with positive test result (Not well enough to work)

- no work sent due to recovery. Parents may support with normal homework tasks if they choose to.

Small contact group needing to self isolate after positive test result

- Parent to contact school to advise of absence.
- Office manager will inform relevant class teacher of expected period of absence.
- Class teacher will communicate with the family via class dojo to sign-post planning information.
- Class teacher to send information via Class email of key objectives being delivered in maths and English for the expected period of absence.
- Class teacher to provide links to relevant websites for lessons and follow-up worksheets
- Class teacher will be available between 3.30pm-4.30pm weekdays for support via Class Dojo or phone call.

Whole class "bubble" needing to self-isolate or whole school closure

- Headteacher will communicate with parents of Class "Bubbles" informing them of expected period of closure
- Work will be set by the class teacher via class email at the beginning of any period of isolation, this will outline key objectives and tasks to be completed each week.
- Class teacher will provide links to relevant websites for lessons and follow-up tasks to be completed.
- Class teacher will be available daily between the hours of 9.00am and 3.30pm to support children's learning via Portfolio and parent messages on class dojo.
- Recorded video lessons and feedback from the class teacher will be provided via the portfolio on Class Dojo

Remote learning will be communicated via Class Dojo and in the event of school or whole "Bubble" closure, on the school website.

Remote learning platforms will include:

- *Class Dojo*
- *Purple Mash*
- *Times Table Rock Stars*
- *BBC Bitesize*
- *Tapestry*

Follow-up tasks may include worksheets which can be completed and submitted online.

Alternatively, if parents choose to print, can be photographed and submitted to the teacher via Class Dojo

In special circumstances, parents may request a paper pack where there is limited access to computers or the internet at home.

An email can be sent to the class teacher at any time during the day, however teachers will only respond to emails during the working week Monday-Friday between 8.30am-4.30pm.
