








<b>Progression</b>	To know that: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Christians believe in God, and that they find out about God in the Bible.</li> <li>Christians believe God is loving, kind, fair and forgiving, and also Lord and King.</li> <li>Some stories show these Christian beliefs.</li> </ul>	To know that: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Christians believe that Jesus is God and that he was born in Bethlehem</li> <li>The Bible points out that his birth showed that he was extraordinary (e.g., he is worshipped as a king) and that he came to bring good</li> </ul>	To know that: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>God created the universe.</li> <li>The Earth and everything in it are important to God.</li> <li>God has a unique relationship with human beings as their Creator and Sustainer.</li> </ul>	To know that: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Easter is very important in the 'big story' of the Bible.</li> <li>Christians believe Jesus rose again, giving people hope of a new life.</li> </ul>	To know that: Various festivals in Christianity and Judaism; the celebrations, stories, artefacts, food. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Purim (held on the 14th day of the Hebrew month of Adar-usually March or April)</li> <li>Sukkot</li> <li>Easter</li> </ul>	Pupils will cover stories from Torah and Bible which cover: My uniqueness as a person in a family and community, caring for others and exploring characteristics such as goodness, kindness.
